

WALKER GALLERY, LIVERPOOL MUSEUM

REINFORCED BITUMEN MEMBRANE SYSTEM



Dating from 1851, The Walker gallery is the largest of eight National Museum's in the city, which together attracts over 1.5 million visitors a year. It houses some of the most prolific works of art in the country from artists including Claude Monet, JMW Turner and David Hockney. Due to the growth of the gallery's collection, it underwent a £35 million redevelopment to more than double the exhibition capacity. Throughout these alterations two main objectives were identified, the doors were to stay open to the public and the priceless artifacts were to remain in situ throughout.

For the roofing system, the Bauder Total Roof System was selected as it fulfilled all the requirements, offering unobtrusive installation and exceptional waterproofing. Continuous onsite support ensured the works were completed on time and with minimum disruption meaning that the museum's public could still enjoy their visit in comfort.
