REINFORCED BITUMEN MEMBRANE OVERLAY



As far back as 1086, Greene King has been brewing all of its beers in the picturesque Suffolk town of Bury St. Edmunds and is totally committed to cask ale, and now produces one of the finest range of cask ales in the world. In 2000 the site was totally renovated including a complete refurbishment of the roof.

The highly adhesive thermally activated SBS elastomeric bitumen coating to the underside is formed into a striped bonding pattern with the areas between surfaced with a special mica quartz finish. The innovative bitumen layout on the underside of the membrane ensures an accurate 50% bond to the existing waterproofing, whilst the mica quartz finish prevents any unwanted adhesion allowing for the controlled dissipation of any vapour pressure if trapped moisture is present in the existing roof, therefore reducing the potential for surface blistering.
