

GREEN ROOF RECREATES ORNATE GARDEN

HORNTON COURT, LONDON



Hornton Court is a red brick Edwardian Building that has been converted into luxury apartments. Traditionally designed with ornate gardens which were removed some years previous to allow the whole area to be paved, the brief was to find a green roof refurbishment to echo the original gardens, but with modern materials that would be versatile and able to meet all current building regulations.

The Bauder Intensive Green Roof System recreated the gardens perfectly. The existing asphalt remained in situ allowing the businesses housed underneath to stay open throughout. The durable waterproofing build up comprised two different drainages, namely PLT10 and PLT20 which are fully compatible with each other - the PLT20 designed to withstand the structural load of the planters and the PLT10 designed for foot traffic. Horton Court now has ornate gardens once again that are the talk of the Kensington High Street.
