

BRONZE FOR BAUDER AT GREEN APPLE AWARDS

CASTLE DROGO, DREWSTEIGHTON, DEVON



Completed in 1930 Castle Drogo, was the last 'castle' built in England featuring one of the earliest modern flat roofs still serviceable in the UK. Set high on a granite outcrop of Dartmoor, it is the jewel in the National Trust's crown, with its unique architecture admired by visitors every year.

The original roof had no visible upstands, with just monolithic granite for the walls and roof surface. The replacement waterproofing linked to a DPC material and coped well with high imposed structural loads. For this reason, and due to compatibility between products, the Bauder Total Roof System together with a high performance bitumen polymer DPC was specified.

The redevelopment of Castle Drogo won bronze at the prestigious Green Apple Awards in the 'Environment and Architectural Heritage' category, the award ceremony took place at the Tower of London and was presented by David Bellamy, OBE.
