

HISTORICAL MONUMENT GOES BAUDER GREEN

ARBROATH ABBEY, ARBROATH



Arbroath Abbey is one of the most important historic buildings in Scotland. Founded by William the Lion in 1178 and dedicated to St. Thomas of Canterbury, this Tironensian Monastery is where Scottish Nobles signed the "Declaration of Arbroath" in 1320, which asserted Scotland's independence from England. Simpson and Brown designed a visitor centre to blend sympathetically with the adjacent Abbey. Featuring three different roof levels, the building is strikingly attractive with its sedum green roofs. Visible to the increasing number of visitors the ever-changing plants enhance the appeal of the site.
