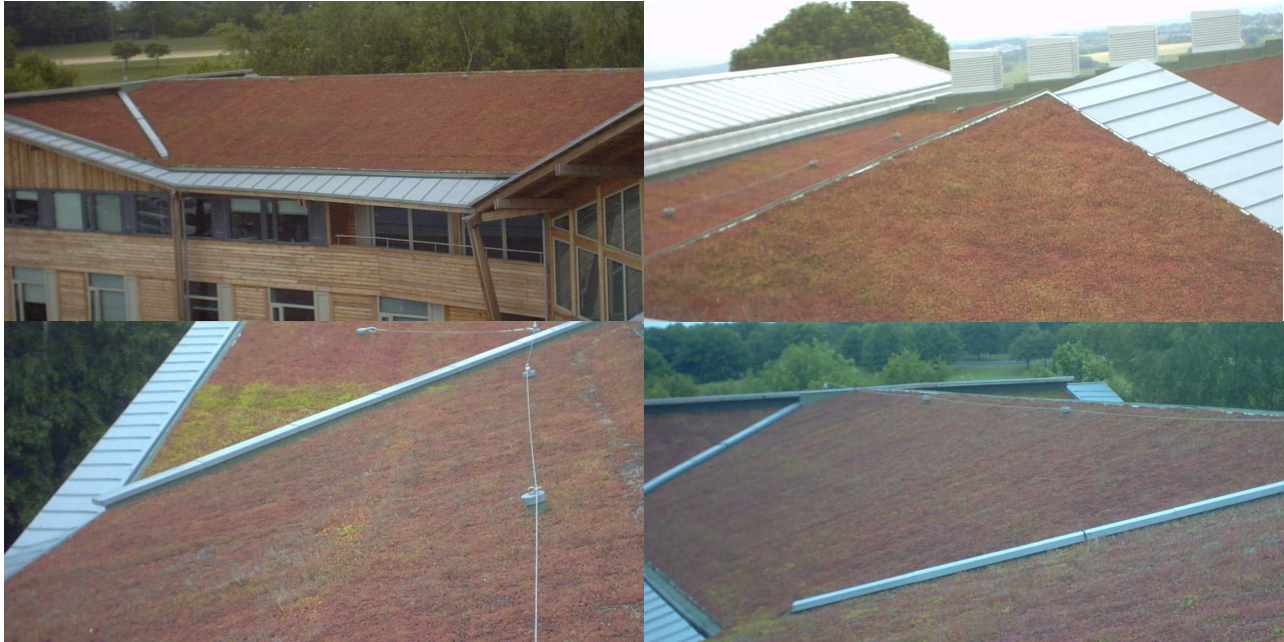


## GREEN ROOF CROWNS AYKLEY HEAD

### AYKLEY HEADS, DURHAM



Aykley Heads, Durham is an office complex situated a mile north of the City Centre. Although surrounded by parkland, they are a few minutes walk from regular bus and train routes into Durham. Amongst the headquarters housed at Aykley Heads are Rivergreen Development, Durham County Council, Northumbrian Tourist Board and Durham Constabulary.

The brief was to make the building an example in environmentally friendly design both during construction and when in use. Sustainable elements were researched, including timber framed roofs, sedum roofs, solar panels and grey water recycling. A Bauder Extensive Green Roof System was selected due to its water absorption, insulation and ecological properties.

Aykley Heads is a building that follows Rivergreen Development's strategy of developing residential and commercial properties that are unique, yet still maintain high standards.
