Bishop Justus School is a visionary building with 43 connecting roof areas comprising of flat, pitched and barrel vaulted roofs. As this three storey, £26 million project was being constructed on Bromley Common, an extensive green roof system was selected in order to replace the green space lost to the footprint of the building. Furthermore, it stands as a reminder of the importance of environmental considerations within the construction industry. The roofs at the Bishop Justus School take ecological ethics out of text books and places them in a reality situation providing pupils, staff and visitors alike with an inspirational atmosphere in which to, relax and learn.
