

BAUDER GREENS ONE-STOP-SHOP

HIRST WELFARE ONE-STOP-SHOP, ASHINGTON



For generations Hirst Welfare was the centre for local communities social and sporting life with local miners making weekly contributions through their pay packets to fund them. However the decline of the mining industry meant that centres ran into disrepair before being demolished. In January 2000 Wansbeck District Council took action establishing four one-stop-shops to install everyday amenities such as libraries and sports facilities back into the local community.

The Architect and client put high emphasis upon the issue of sustainability within this project due to its location on a 'green' site. A Bauder Extensive Green Roof System in combination with the Bauder Single Ply System was selected as it provided the ideal solution, echoing the environmental requirements and enhancing the shape of the building, with mono-pitched roofs connected to single storey blocks to create a major part of the overall design.
