SAINSBURY CENTRE FOR VISUAL ARTS, NORWICH



The Sainsbury Centre of Visual Arts, University of East Anglia was built in 1990, designed by Foster and Partners. It boasts an impressive green roof that blends the building straight into its surroundings. The large turfed area acts as an extension to the University's grounds where students and visitors can relax.

The Bauder Intensive Green Roof System was installed and only required the maintenance routine associated with a grass lawn. Completely camouflaging any evidence of the building that lies beneath, it would be impossible to tell of its existence if it were not for the roof lights running the entire width of the roof. Not only supplying an aesthetically pleasing finish, the Bauder Green Roof System and waterproofing build means that the roof remains 100% watertight giving the client complete confidence that the original works of art, housed within the museum are secure.
