### TOWER OF LONDON, LONDON



Construction on the Tower of London began in the early 1080's under the rule of William the Conqueror as a visual reminder of his triumph over his predecessor, and went on to be best known for its gory history, as a place of incarceration and execution, despite fulfilling many roles throughout the years.

Going through various alterations across the coming centuries, The Tower of London we see today was remodelled in the 1850's by Anthony Salvin and John Taylor in order to restore the gothic, medieval appearance following the Victorian's new found interest in the history and architecture of this now globally iconic building.

In 1992 Bauder brought the Tower of London into the 20<sup>th</sup> Century with the installation of a Bauder Intensive Green Roof over the Tower Gift Shop. This provided an open expanse of turf for the public to sit and enjoy the historic site, a waterproofing solution that fulfilled all of the strict requirements identified in the brief and gave the gift shop a unique appeal to the 2 million visitors attracted to the Tower each year.
