Objective:

Reporting to the Warehouse Supervisor, you will be responsible for all Warehouse processes, involving materials entering/exiting Bauder HQ. This will include unloading/loading vehicles, checking deliveries/picked orders, stock location, returned materials and quality control. These requirements will be implemented correctly and efficiently, whilst upholding the standards of the business, maximising productivity, and ensuring service delivery of the highest level.

You will possess a positive attitude, and work closely with other departments within the business, ensuring provision of excellent customer service skills to both internal and external stakeholders.

Outline of main responsibilities:

- Coordinate opening and/or closing the warehouse and yard as required
- Coordinate the warehouse operational duties
- Checking receipts of stock and location of incoming materials into the warehouse
- Checking all orders for despatch including quality control
- Yard supervision and control of incoming vehicles
- Overseeing materials returned to the warehouse, location and processes
- Overseeing materials in QA hold, location and processes
- Reporting on warehouse consumable material stock levels (pallets, skids, packaging, shrink wrap etc)
- Ensure good housekeeping and cleanliness appropriate for warehouse environment
- Reporting when waste skips require emptying
- Continuous improvement of all warehouse processes

Supporting the Warehouse Supervisor:

- Implementing rotas
- Proactively motivate and provide guidance to the warehouse team
- Monitor and provide feedback on team performance
- Reporting on non-conformance issues
- Coordinate shelf-life inspections, hazardous waste, cycle counts and assist with stock takes
- Assist with inspection of premises and equipment to ensure cleanliness and good working order
- Assist with monitoring of forklift and other equipment to ensure optimal function
- Reporting security issues/concerns to the Warehouse Supervisor

- Assisting with goods in, picking and loading as required
- Help and support in other areas as required

Requirements in Absence of Warehouse Supervisor:

- Point of contact for warehouse team
- Work with Logistics Supervisor and management team to maintain operations
- Maintain/create rota's
- Oversight of import trailers
- Manager stags and picking order in conjunction with Logistics Supervisor
- Maintain all returns and QA processes
- Communicate all issues to Management
- All standards as above to be consistently maintained with workload cleared and deadlines met
- You are required to adopt a flexible approach to working additional hours to ensure business needs are met. This may involved adopting a shift pattern and working weekends as required. Advance notice would be given.

Health and Safety:

- Full adherence and monitoring of all Health and Safety Regulations.
- Full awareness and adherence to Bauder UK processes and procedures for the warehouse.
- Reporting of accidents, incidents, near misses and concerns to Warehouse Supervisor / Management, immediately.
- Adherence and monitoring of Covid-19 processes and procedures and be aware of changes and updates.
